BEGINNING

HISTORY

1948

San Antonio Livestock Exposition (S.A.L.E.) was founded.

1950

On February 17, the first Annual San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo was held. The first exposition met with unparalleled success, entertaining more than a quarter of a million visitors, an unheard-of record for an opening show.

1984

Awarded 15 four-year scholarships totaling \$90,000 to students entering Texas colleges in fall 1984.

1999

The San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo Hall of Fame was developed. Joe Freeman, Harry Freeman and Mary Nan West were the first inductees.

2003

Rodeo and concert performances move to a **brand new, state-of-the-art facility**, the AT&T Center (formerly the SBC Center) right next door.

2005

The Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association (PRCA) awarded the **San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo Large Indoor Rodeo of the Year for the first time.**

2006

The San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo **doubled its giving** in the three years since moving into the AT&T Center.

2008

The San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo is **inducted in the PRCA Hall of Fame.**

2016

The San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo educational commitment **exceeds \$171.4 million**, with \$11.3 million committed in 2016 scholarships, grants, endowments, junior livestock auctions, youth Western art auction, calf scramble program and show premiums.

It's a simple foundation and makes a lasting impression. We work all year long to support our mission and core values. We don't do it overnight. And we can't do it alone.


As a nonprofit 501c3 organization, we know that every dollar matters and all contributions count.

The San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo is dedicated to creating a meaningful legacy to support new generations of Texans in pursuit of agriculture education. We host millions of visitors at dozens of events and fundraisers as well as world-class rodeo action and entertainment. They all carry a powerful community impact and help generate financial support for Texas youth.

We also organize more than 6,000 volunteers who serve on more than 40 committees to further support our mission all year. Those numbers are great, but the results are even greater. Our efforts generate scholarships, grants, endowments, auctions, show premiums and other prize-winning activities, that add up to millions of dollars in educational commitment for Texas youth every year.

ANIMAL CARE

We're committed to maintaining high standards in animal care excellence. We require the proper care and treatment of all animals for display, competition, exhibition and educational purposes. Every year, we're entrusted with more than 70,000 animals on our property during the run of the San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo. We're serious about making sure that all of our animals are treated with respect for their well-being.



ASSETS, FACILITIES AND GROUNDS

It takes a lot to keep the San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo running strong.

We're fortunate to have dedicated, state-of-the-art and climate-controlled space to spread out in every year. We've expanded our original footprint at the Freeman Coliseum to include an even larger presence over the years.

We use about 308 acres to put on the whole show, but it's not only about taking up a lot of space. It's also about using it well and maintaining what we have. Our organization is fiscally conservative, responsible and proud of our long-running business partnerships. **We strategically manage our assets to maximize the experience for everybody involved in the San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo—for now and for the long term.**



We're also responsible stewards of our environment. The San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo is proud to earn the City of San Antonio's Green Event Level of Verde, the highest designation possible, for recycling, waste reduction and energy management.

IMPACT

We're proud of our history of stewardship to the San Antonio community and rich tradition of supporting the agriculture industry and youth of Texas. Our efforts produce a meaningful impact not only in terms of educating more students, but also in terms of boosting the local economy and encouraging widespread support for our mission.

Two million visitors come through the San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo each year. They bring a powerful sales tax boost along with them.

PRESTIGE AND EXPOSURE

Our productive relationships with the City of San Antonio and Bexar County help ensure long-term support for our mission.

We don't receive or solicit any state or federal dollars.

Yet, our impact on the local economy is measurable.

We help put San Antonio and South Texas on the map in our industry and beyond. All over the country, leaders in agriculture, animal care, rodeo sports and entertainment look to us for responsible stewardship and best practices. That's a great responsibility and privilege we're proud to maintain.

More importantly, a significant percentage of our strong and growing economic impact comes from non-local sources. It

means people go out of their way to come to San Antonio and stay to spend more time and money here. **Every state in the union is represented at the San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo, and at last count, 95 countries have also been included.**

Economic studies credit the San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo with contributing more than \$250 million in impact on our local economy. That only covers the time of our main event in February. Our nonprofit organization and volunteers produce events and fundraisers all year to generate ongoing support for our mission.

VOLUNTEERS MAKE EVERYTHING HAPPEN



- ★ **A winner every night:** There's no waiting for our Rodeo to be over before we announce winners. We keep the fun rolling every day.
- ★ **The largest purses:** It's no fun to compete for small potatoes. We make it worth their while.
- ★ **Fast pace:** From start to finish, our Rodeo is built to run in two hours that pack a lot of action.
- ★ **State-of-the-art venue:** The AT&T Center can hold almost 17,000 people in comfort with entertainment on the floor and digital displays all around.



COMPETITIVE YOUTH EVENTS

Youth competitions breed respect, grace and lessons of a lifetime.

We believe in friendly, but serious, competition. It may seem small: Showing an animal bred to compete. Demonstrating horse training and skills. Learning how to judge events. But, in all these contests, we also see greatness for Texas youth.

Our competitions help youth learn about animal care, skill and the agriculture industry. More importantly, they also teach responsibility and time management, present new career paths, inspire opportunity and show new generations of Texans how to be gracious in the face of victory or defeat.

Supporting these competitive events for Texas youth is why the San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo exists. As a nonprofit organization, we depend on help from volunteers to make it all run. They're happy to share what they know with youth who are ready to learn, even if it means staying late and putting in hours of their time. We have many ways you can help support them, too.

The San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo also provides a fertile proving ground for new competitive events for youth. From agrobotics to food and landscape challenges, new potential scholarship awards grow every year.

HIGHLIGHTS OF COMPETITIVE YOUTH EVENTS

- ★ **Livestock Show:** Beef and dairy cattle, chickens, turkeys, pigs, goats and sheep are exhibited and win awards for the young participants who show them.
- ★ **Horse Show:** From barrel racing to demonstrating other skills, we have many ways for youth to show their horses.
- ★ **Landscape Skillathon:** This covers everything from design concepts to fertilizers, insecticides and plant identification skills.
- ★ **Food Challenge:** It's like Iron Chef, but requires student contestants to know about preparation, nutritional facts and ingredient origins.
- ★ **Junior Shootout:** The richest youth clay target competition in the country awards scholarships and prizes for shotgun shooting sports.
- ★ **Student Western Arts:** Designed to generate scholarships and showcase student passion for art expressed through different mediums, it's a creative outlet for Western heritage and tradition.
- ★ **Agricultural Mechanics Show:** With elements of competition and a marketplace, this event helps turn ag skills into sales and includes a job fair and auction.

FUNDRAISERS ALL YEAR


Bar-B-Que Cook-off & Festival: Part of the kick-off to rodeo season, this event pits the world's champion grillers against each other for delicious fun and competition housed at our generously donated San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo on the Salado. It includes live music, family activities, a BBQ trade show, shopping and even a cook-off competition just for the kids. Proceeds benefit the San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo Scholarship Fund.

Rodeo Round-up: It's one of the largest fundraisers of the year for the San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo Scholarship Fund. Guests look forward to delicious food and drinks, live music, door prizes and auctions.

Cowgirls Live Forever: This luncheon and fashion show stages the latest trends and styles while bringing in more than \$1 million in scholarships. It honors independent, courageous and resilient women who are dedicated to preserving Western heritage and helping to shape Texas agriculture and Texas youth.

Golf Tournament: The Tee'r Up Golf Tournament is a whole weekend of golf and fun to bring in more money to benefit the San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo Scholarship Fund.

Boots and Shoot: Competitive clay shooters get a chance to showcase their skills at this event that supports the Calf Scramble program. After a day of shooting, the event continues with dinner, live music, dancing and auctions.





FUN RODEO EVENTS

★ **Western Heritage Parade & Cattle Drive:** The traditional kick-off to the San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo, it's a spectacle that stretches down historic Houston Street and the iconic Alamo.

★ **Wine Garden and Craft Beer Garden:** The best spots to cool your heels with a cool one and savor winning vintages, techniques and food pairings.

★ **Concerts:** Live music comes in lots of forms, whether it's major headline acts inside the AT&T Center's main stage or at multiple other venues throughout our grounds.

★ **Family Activities:** From a petting zoo, to pony rides, to a full-on Texas Family Experience, there are exhibits, samples and hands-on fun designed for the whole family.

★ **Carnival:** Games and rides from one of the largest carnival providers in the country.

★ **Shops at the Rodeo:** Hundreds of carefully curated vendors showcase items like furnishings, accessories, clothes and boots in a climate-controlled setting.





JUNIOR LIVESTOCK AUCTION

Getting animals ready for the Junior Livestock Auction is a long-term commitment. It's usually also a family experience.

Our competitors feed, groom and care for their animals, and keep records of it all. They get up before school and put in hundreds of hours, weeks after months, to get it done. Then, they come to show it all for a chance to help pay for their continuing education. Along the way, these competitors don't just learn how to raise livestock. **They also learn basic life skills and character builders, like responsibility, accountability and the value of hard work.**

That level of drive and dedication is impressive enough. But, when you consider the participants are in 4H and FFA—that's grade school and high school—it's remarkable.

EVERY DOLLAR COUNTS

Here's something you might not realize about the San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo Junior

Livestock Auction: Every dollar earned goes straight to the competitors—the youth of Texas. The house doesn't get a cut. There's no overhead fee or percentage taken out. It's all to support our mission. **We see to it that every dollar goes exactly where it's meant to go. Contributors and supporters really do make a difference here.**
